- Management reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without notice prior to or during the show.
- The Jubilee Regional Morgan Horse Show reserves the right to refuse entries.
- Corrections to this prize list will appear on the Show's web site: www.jubileemorganhorseshow.org
- The Show assumes no responsibility for situations and actions resulting from an individual serving alcohol on the Fairgrounds

AGE OF RIDER

- The age of an individual on December 1 will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. (GR103)
- Amateur rider/driver/handler must be at least 18 years old.
- Ladies and Gentlemen rider/driver must be at least 18 years old.
- Youth rider/driver must be 21 years old or younger.

AMATEUR CERTIFICATION

 CARDS. Every person who competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. See GR1306 and GR1307. All exhibitors 18 & over in Classic Pleasure classes are required to have amateur certification.

ARENAS, WARM UP & EXERCISE AREAS

- The Footing in all arenas consists of a mixture of loam/sand organic matter.
- Indoor warm up areas barn 13 and barn 14 100'x 125' each
- Covered warm up ring is 250'x 190'
- Lunging is not allowed in the Coliseum at anytime
- Turnout is not allowed in any arena at any time

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Move-in begins Monday August 28, at \$120 per stall. All entrants have the option of moving in Sunday August 27, beginning at 11:00 am at the rate of \$145 per stall.
 However, due to conflicts at the Illinois State Fairgrounds on Sunday, you will have to make arrangements with Sandy Sessink to be assured that she can make your stalls available when you arrive. PLEASE INDICATE YOUR EXPECTED DAY AND TIME OF ARRIVAL ON YOUR ENTRY FORM.

ASSOCIATION/FEDERATION FEES

- The Drugs and Medications fee has been incorporated into the USEF fee which will be assessed at \$23.00 per horse per competition; this includes the \$15.00 drugs & medication fee and the \$8.00 USEF fee.
- All participants (rider, driver, handler, owner, trainer, coach, agent or lessee) must present to the Show Secretary a current USEF and AMHA membership card or copy thereof. All participants must either join USEF on line, or purchase a non-member fee on line, NOT THROUGH THE SHOW OFFICE. If a participant is entered in classes restricted to amateurs, the participant will be required to purchase a membership with amateur certification.
- A copy of the appropriate, current USEF and AMHA membership card(s) must be sent with entries.

ASSOCIATION/FEDERATION RULES

USEF

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

AMHA

 Standard or Premium Level, Life, Individual and Junior AMHA Members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at the Grand National & World Championship Morgan Horse Show[®] without further charge. Associate level AMHA members may participate upon payment of \$35 fee to upgrade to Standard Level, or non-member fee of \$45. (Nonmembers may participate as a rider, driver, owner, lessee, coach, agent or trainer upon payment of a \$45.00 fee.) Participants in leadline, walk-trot classes and residents of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their national federation are exempted from the requirements of this rule.

ATTENTION GETTING DEVICES AND FORBIDDEN APPLIANCES

- Attention-getting devices and/or other noisemakers (including but not limited to tape measures, blow horns, altered bamboo poles, explosives, etc.) are not allowed in and around the makeup/ schooling/ warm-up and competition rings during the scheduled competition sessions.
- Use of explosives and fire extinguishers by or for exhibitors/competitors (except in the case of fire) are not allowed on competition grounds at any time. GR839.4j and GR840.

ATTIRE AND ENTRANCE TO RING

• All riders/drivers/handlers, attendants and awards presenters must be neatly and appropriately attired to enter the show ring for all performances or may be denied entrance.

CAMPING

Camper fees are paid directly to the Illinois State Fair. Rates and more information available here: <u>Illinois State Fair Campgrounds</u>

CANCELATION OR COMBINING OF CLASSES

• Management has the right to combine or cancel any class at their discretion.

CHECKS RETURNED/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS

 All checks returned for insufficient funds or credit cards declined for any reason will be charged a \$50 handling fee and must be replaced by a certified check or cashier's check. No one will be allowed to show if he/she has a returned check, declined credit card or handling fee outstanding.

DOGS AND OTHER PETS

Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7. Please clean up after your pets.

ENTERING

 Cross-entering is allowed between the Classic Pleasure (Driving or Saddle) Sections and the English Pleasure or Pleasure Driving Sections, provided the toe and shoeing requirements are met. Cross-entering between the Classic Pleasure Sections and all other Sections is also allowed.

ENTRIES

- One owner per entry blank.
- Entry Blanks must be completed in full, signed and accompanied by full payment, and all AMHA and USEF numbers listed. Memberships will be verified electronically;

however, you may be required to present a copy of your card or papers if they are unable to be verified.

- Horses which are owned by a farm or entity must possess a USEF membership for that farm or entity or pay the USEF show pass fee. A current USEF membership for the individual listed as the farm/entity owner does not fulfill the USEF membership requirement.
- Cash, check or credit card may be used to pay for entries. NEW THIS YEAR...Credit card payments will be accepted with a 5% fee to cover what the bank charges us for this service.
- If the owner or exhibitor is under 18 years of age, the Entry Blank must be signed by a representative who is of age and who, by such a signature, individually assumes responsibility and risk as stated above the signature. The Show assumes no responsibility and this shall be a condition of entry.
- Closing Date of Entries: ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY AUGUST 9, 2021.
- Entries after this date will be assessed a \$30 per horse late entry fee.
- No horse will be allowed to enter the show ring without having a back number issued and a payment on file in the show office. Exhibitors will be required to present their health and Coggins certificates and any other necessary information in order to receive horse numbers.

FEED AND BEDDING

- <u>All feed and bedding must be ordered through Sandy Sessink</u> at 248-207-4956.
- Shavings shall be \$11.00 per bag, INCLUDING delivery, bedding each stall prior to your arrival and taking the bags away.
- All orders during the show can also be made by calling, or texting Sandy, with the "last call" for hay or bedding orders being at 4:00 pm on Friday afternoon.

GOLF CARTS

 Golf carts must be pre-ordered directly with the company, Battery Specialists. Their phone number is 217-824-3943. Carts must be ordered at least 5 days prior to requested delivery date. However, considering past history, it's best to order as soon as possible, as they run out periodically.

HEADERS

• Headers in the Morgan Division must be a minimum of 16 years of age and dressed appropriately (USEF horse show age, see GR103).

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Vaccinations: At Federation licensed competitions, horses more than seven months
of age entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine
Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six
months prior to entering the stables. Refer to USEF GR845.1 for those that cannot

- All Illinois horses more than 12 months of age are required to have a negative Coggins test for EIA within the last 12 months. All out-of-state horses more than 12 months of age must have a negative test for EIA within the past 12 months and be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection or Health Certificate issued within the past 30 days. Foals by their dam's side do not need a Coggins, however, their dam must have a valid Coggins test.
- The State of Illinois requires that all out-of-state horses have an Entry Permit Number (See below). A certificate of veterinary inspection and entry permit are not required for equines residing in Illinois full time. Illinois equines traveling out-of-state on an Illinois Certificate of veterinary inspection are not required to obtain a permit to return home.

ENTRY PERMIT NUMBERS FOR OUT OF STATE HORSES: All equine entering Illinois (for any reason other than slaughter) must be accompanied by a negative test for EIA conducted within a year if the animal is more than one year of age, certificate of veterinary inspection (health certificate) issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days of entry, and an entry permit number issued by the Illinois Department of Agriculture. Entry permit numbers are available by calling the Illinois Department of Agriculture, 217-782-4944 and are issued 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Permit numbers are also available online at <u>www.agr.state.il.us.</u> A password to access the permit program is required and will be issued to veterinarians by calling the Illinois Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Animal Health, 217- 782-4944 weekdays, 8:00am-4:30pm.

- The following information will be required for the entry permit number:
- Name and mailing address of the owner of the animal;
- Date of the EIA test;
- Location where the animal is going.
- THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR OBTAINING AN ENTRY PERMIT NUMBER FROM THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

HEARING DEVICES

 Electronic communication devices used for purposes of coaching exhibitors during a competition are prohibited in all classes in the Morgan Division. Exhibitors with a permanent hearing impairment are permitted to use an electronic communication device upon submission of a written certification from a treating medical professional's office certifying the permanent hearing impairment and certifying the requirement of an electronic communication device. The medical certification must be provided to the competition Steward, within a reasonable time prior to competing, who shall attach a copy to the Steward report.

HOLDS

• All holds must be requested with the show manager a minimum of 2 hours prior to the start of the session in which the hold is needed. All holds will be 2 minutes in length. Once a hold is incorporated into the session, it will not be canceled.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE

 The show office will open from 11am-6pm on Monday August 28th and 9am-5pm on Tuesday August 29th for check in. Trainers may make a check in appointment online, the link to do so will be available on the show website. On show days, the office will be open 1.5 hours prior and 30 minutes after the session. Adds and scratches may also be completed online via <u>www.horseshowing.com</u> All accounts must be settled on Saturday night, the show office will not be open Sunday.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages. claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

PERSONS NOT IN GOOD STANDING

 Persons who are not in good standing with USEF, AMHA, this Show or any Regional Show may not participate in this Show, whether as an exhibitor, owner, trainer or otherwise. This policy includes all horses registered in the name of any such person, whether leased or under contract for sale. Procedures have been established to resolve any disputes concerning accounts with USEF, AMHA, this Show or any Regional Show.

QUALIFICATION

- Amateur classes are restricted to Amateurs 18 years and over. Junior Exhibitors will qualify for amateur championships when no junior exhibitor championship is offered, however they will be judged by amateur class specifications.
- Ladies and Gentleman's classes will qualify for their respective amateur championships if shown by an amateur in the qualifying class, and <u>ONLY if a Ladies Championship in</u> your division is NOT offered.
- AMHA Medal Classes and UPHA Challenge Cup classes will qualify the rider for the respective equitation championship.

REFUNDS

- Refunds will only be issued if requested in writing prior to the closing date of entry, less the \$30 office fee.
- NO REFUNDS will be made if an exhibitor misses a class for any reason and the class has not been properly scratched in the show office prior to the session in which the class occurred.

REGISTRATION

- All horses entered in the show must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., the Canadian Morgan Horse Association, or the British Morgan Horse Society and must be entered under their full registered name or if under one year of age be eligible for registration.
- Registration certificates or a copy thereof for each horse must be available for inspection, examination and verification by an official designated by AMHA during the show. Horses must be entered under the ownership which appears on the registration.

SAFE SPORT POLICY

 All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at <u>www.usef.org.</u>

STABLING

- Permanent and portable stalls with full doors will be available on a first come first serve basis at the rate of \$120 for Monday arrivals and \$145 for Sunday arrivals.
- Stabling will be assigned based on history and location on an annual basis with careful consideration for efficient use of the total available stalls.
- Exhibitors will be liable for any damage caused by them to stalls or buildings.
- Please contact the show manager with your stall counts at 248-207-4956
- All stabling assignments and counts become final on August 25th. You will be charged for all stalls reserved by this date.

SCRATCHES AND ADDS

- Any class entered or scratched during the show must be entered TWO HOURS before the session in which the class is to be held.
- You will be charged for any class which is not scratched properly in the office prior to the session.

SHARPS DISPOSAL

• Safe and proper sharps disposal (needles, syringes and other hazardous objects and materials) is the responsibility of individual stables. Containers are available throughout the stabling area.
